## Registration fee

Payable on registration, non-refundable **£150**

## Deposits

Please see the Berkhamsted Schools Group's Terms and Conditions for information on how and when the Acceptance Deposit and/or the Additional Deposit may be refunded. The Acceptance/Additional Deposits are subject to change and reference should be made to the published Terms and Conditions and Fees Schedule applicable at the time of Acceptance.

**Acceptance Deposit - (£2,000** payable by the parents of each pupil on acceptance of a place)

Fees are payable on the first day of term either by direct debit, bank transfer or debit card.

Families living overseas applying for a Day Place, at the time of offer, will be subject to an additional deposit which will be refunded once a move to the UK has taken place.

**Overseas Additional Deposit** payable by parents who are resident outside the United Kingdom
